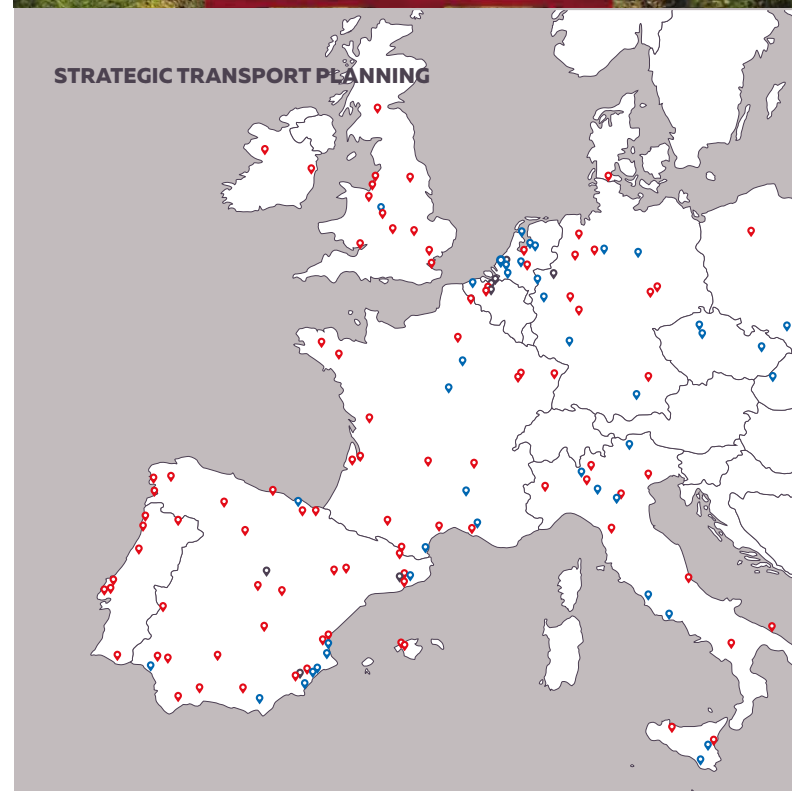
REPLACING EQUIPMENT

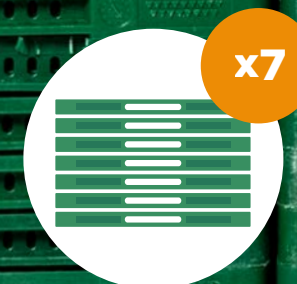

Old trays are 100% recyclable and processed into reusable granulate that can be used to make new trays.



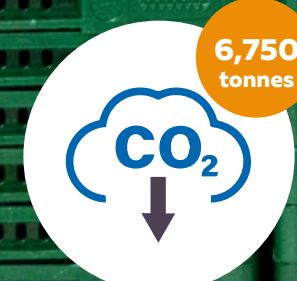
PROJECT CYAN: TRANSITION TO THINNER TRAYS



A folded green tray occupies **7 times less space** than a rigid blue tray
